#### **GRANTS - OUR FUNDS IN ACTION**

Mark your calendars for a chance to tour the **Mother's Helping Mothers** (MHM) facility on July 14th at either 10am or 11:30 am. They are going to open their doors to members of Impact100 SRQ so we can see how our grant funds are being used in a transformative and sustainable way. In our first year of grant funding we awarded \$114,000 to Mothers Helping Mothers (MHM). With those funds MHM was able to purchase their building and close on it at the end of January 2020. Since then, they have been able to allocate what would have been funds to pay the rent, to help more families in need. MHM was able to keep their doors open throughout 2020, despite a pandemic, partly because they did not have to worry about rent expense.


MHM has been supporting local families for 30 years. Thanks to generous donors, grant funding and a volunteer only staff, they have been able to **serve over** 

They operate a 5,000 sq. ft. space full of FREE, gently used items available to any family in need. Items range from clothing for the entire family to kitchen, bedding, and bath supplies.

MHM ensures every child, despite economic situations, is provided with proper, necessary equipment for sleeping and transportation by providing new cribs, bassinets, toddler beds, and all stages of car seats to clients in need, along with an array of gently used baby equipment.

Shopping is by appointment only, once every four months. MHM provides referrals, support services, in-house classes and for qualified families, a one-time-only, financial assistance to further stabilize and enhance their families lives.
