### Sobi Cares Spotlight: Kelly Saba

This month we are featuring Kelly Saba, a Field Reimbursement Senior Manager for Sobi North America. Kelly is based in Sarasota, FL and joined Sobi a year and a half ago. If you would like to share about an organization you are passionate about, email Devika Narayan.



#### Tell us a bit about the nonprofit you support and what you do.

I am a Founding Member and an integral part of the Membership Committee Board for Impact100's Sarasota Chapter. Impact100 SRQ is a women-led organization that encourages at least 100 women to donate \$1,000 each, and then pools those resources into one large grant to be awarded to deserving nonprofits in the Sarasota and Manatee counties across five broad focus areas: Arts & Culture, Education, Environment, Preservation & Recreation, Family and Health & Wellness.



In our 2019 founding year, Impact 100 SRQ raised \$228,000 and awarded two transformational grants of \$114,000 each to The Haven and Mothers Helping Mothers:

- **The Haven** offers programs and services for adults and children with disabilities to enhance quality of life by encouraging independence, championing inclusion, and advocating for their individual rights. The grant Impact100 SRQ provided will fund the expansion of The Haven's preschool facility to accommodate even more children.
- **Mothers Helping Mothers** provides necessities such as clothing and baby items free of charge to families in need in the Sarasota and surrounding counties. The grant we provided will go toward the purchase of the building they are currently leasing.

In 2020, Impact 100 SRQ raised \$342,000 which will award three transformational grants of \$114,000 to three Sarasota-Manatee nonprofits this November. Area nonprofits are currently submitting their projects and programs, and our Impact this year is more important than ever since COVID-19 has created greater needs than we ever imagined in our community.

#### What inspired you to get involved?



I was inspired to join Impact100 SRQ because it shows how one person can truly make meaningful change. By sharing my passion and love for people, being an active member of Impact100 SRQ is empowering me to make a difference in my community.

Being a Founding Member has connected me directly with the true needs of our community, and we are blazing the philanthropic trail for generations of women to come. Formulating the recruiting process has allowed me to use my passion and giving heart to bring hundreds of women together, making us the largest second-year chapter in the world. Recruiting new members is easy for me because I believe in the power of collective giving. Sharing my skills with this 100% volunteer organization fulfills my desire to make a positive difference.

Supporting Impact100 SRQ has also given me a clear understanding of the power of collective giving. It has opened my eyes to the many different nonprofits and needs in my community. It has shown me that it is within my power to create change. My donation, time and passion are having an impact that is greater than I ever dreamed possible.
